Where is the Victory Missions office located?

We have **TWO** locations to which you can turn in things such as **paperwork, payments, and passports.**

Location 1: West Building Missions Office (3rd Floor of Victory Christian School)

There is also a drop box bolted to the ground at the front entrance that can be used after hours.

Location 2: East Building Missions Office (3rd Floor of the 24.7 / VBC Building located on 81st and Delaware)

There is a drop box bolted to the wall next to the elevator to be used after hours.

What is Managed Missions?

- A website (managedmissions.com) created to track your student's personal progress providing numerous resources
- You will receive an **email** including your personal login and password once your information has been entered
- You can use your login information to access Managed Missions at any time to:
 - Download travel documents
 - Follow important upcoming dates and deadlines
 - Access a fundraising guide
 - Track all of your payments and keep up on your trip balance

It is **extremely important** to provide the **correct phone number and email address** for which all missions trip correspondence relayed. Including: managed missions account login, meeting and training information and all other important updates.

What paperwork do I need to turn in?

- All completed travel documents (including notary) must be turned in to the mission's office.
- This includes: Trip Agreement, Medical History, Medical Release, Doctors Release (if applicable) and Travel Release (if applicable) and Financial Agreement.
- **At this time we do have a notary in our office that can notarize Travel forms**
- The health and safety of your student is extremely important to us and we want to make sure that we do everything we can to take the best care of them possible as they travel with us on missions.

What does the trip price include?

The trip price covers the cost for transportation to/from and within the country, food, lodging, trip insurance as well as missions training, administrative, leadership and trip set up costs. The price does not include passport fees or the cost of returning home early due to violation of the rules.

How do I raise money for my trip?

We will provide fundraising opportunities but we encourage each team member to write a support letter, a sample one has been included in this packet.

Who will lead the trips?

Every mission's team has two levels of leadership. The Project Directors, one male and one female, share the responsibility for all aspects of the trip – logistics, coordination with national leaders, spiritual growth, ministry assignments and enforcing Victory Missions standards. MIG Leaders (**MI**nistry **G**roup Leaders) focus on building relationship with the teen missionaries and guiding the daily schedule and ministry activities.

Will I be safe during the trip?

Absolutely! The safety of our teams is one of our highest priorities. We partner with local missionaries to ensure we are staying and ministering in safe places. We also have two levels of leadership within our teams so no one is ever alone. Plus, we have a nurse/doctor on each team working with us at our destination.

Are there rules I have to follow?

Yes. Every missionary signs a Trip Agreement showing their commitment to uphold the values and ministry expectations of the team.

What if I have a special diet?

Some destinations are more challenging than others. However, we will make every effort to accommodate your needs regarding food allergies. In some situations, families may need to send food with the student. Please contact our office to discuss your needs.

Will you train me so I know how to share and serve?

All of the Victory Mission trips include specific training for ministry skills like sharing your testimony and talking to people about Jesus, as well as customs and safety for the country/region where you are traveling.

What if I can't speak the language?

A smile, a hug, and acts of kindness are understood in every language. Translators will partner with us on the missions field to help when needed.
