This is a God Dream pt 3: The Dream of Serving

In this lesson you will learn about three aspects of God's dream.

Intro: God dreams will go with you into eternity and inevitably make an eternal impact on people's lives. A dream from God can only be achieved with God's help. God's dream for your life is not a destination, but an exploration. Your part matters. Your presence matters. Your serving matters. Matt 20:5-28 The greatest in the Kingdom will be the servant. What if serving others wasn't a means to an end towards your dream? What if serving others was the dream?

I. God has a Dream for the Church

- A. Matt 16:18- God is a master builder, and He is building a glorious Church. The Church is the house that God is building. The Church has always been about you and me. The church is not built around the gifts of some, but the sacrifice of many. See yourself as part of the team. See yourself as part of the family bringing vital callings and tools to the table. The church cannot be built without you. We need you. God needs you.

II. Connect with God's Dream for the local Church

- A. Mark 12:30-31 The vision of this house is to love God and love people. In order to connect with God's dream, we must; stay humble, stay hungry, and stay thankful. We have the opportunity to serve the local church body rather than obligated to serve. Never take on the attitude of entitlement, but continue to endure in the heart of a servant. Jesus is our example and our master. He did not come to be served, but to serve others (Matt 20:28).

III. Partner with God's Dream

- A. Be the best you can be right where you are. Make the most of what you have right now. Use what you have to help fulfill God's dream. Serve with a kind heart. God's dream for your life begins on the platform of your current season. If you're too big to serve, then you're too small to lead. Your heart to serve will open doors in your life to bring even more glory to God. The God dream flows out of serving. The greatest title you will ever receive is Well done thou good and faithful servant (Matt 25:23). Seize the moment to serve.
