Introduction: This story is widely known as “the woman with the issue (of blood)”. The un-named woman initiated her own healing after hearing about Jesus. He then turned to the woman and pronounced her whole. “Your faith plus His power makes anything possible.”

1. She heard about Jesus’ healing ministry. Mar 5:27a KJV - When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind... Rom 10:17 KJV - So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

2. She took action even when Jesus had not noticed her. Mar 5:27b, 30 KJV - ...she...came in the press behind, and touched his garment. :30 - And Jesus...turned him about in the press, and said, Who touched my clothes?

3. She focused her thoughts and words on the answer. Mat 9:21 AMP - for she had been saying to herself, "If I only touch His outer robe, I will be healed." Heb 11:1 RSV - Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

4. She was healed as soon as she touched Jesus’ garment. Mar 5:29 RSV - And immediately the hemorrhage ceased; and she felt in her body that she was healed of her disease.
