Key Passage: Ephesians 4:1-6 NKJV

I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you **to walk worthy of the calling** with which you were called, ² with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, ³ endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. ⁴ *There is* one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; ⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism; ⁶ one God and Father of all, who *is* above all, and through all, and in you all.

Introduction:

As believers in Christ, we are to walk worthy of the calling that Christ has called each one of us to.

Walking Worthy of our Calling means walking in:

- 1. **Humility (V. 2) Romans 12:3** "For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think *of himself* more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith."
- 2. **Gentleness (V.2) Proverbs 15:1** "A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger."
- 3. Patience (V.2) I Corinthians 13:4 "Love is Patient, love is kind...."
- 4. **Bearing with Each Other in Love (V. 2) Galatians 5:22-23** "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law."
- 5. Making Effort to be United in Peace Ephesians 4:3
- 6. We're All A Part of the Same Family Ephesians 4:4
