Ways to Let Him Cook:

1. Trust the chef - **Proverbs 3:5-6**
2. Let go of what you can't control. Forgiveness, shame, revenge, anger, bitterness
3. Focus on being the cook of your own soul. **Proverbs 4:23**
4. Give God all the ingredients. **Psalm 150:6**
